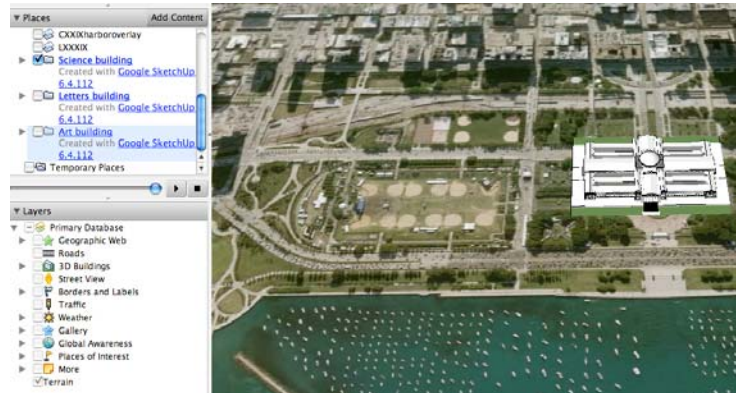
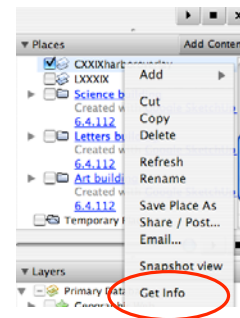


Viewing KMZ files in Google Earth

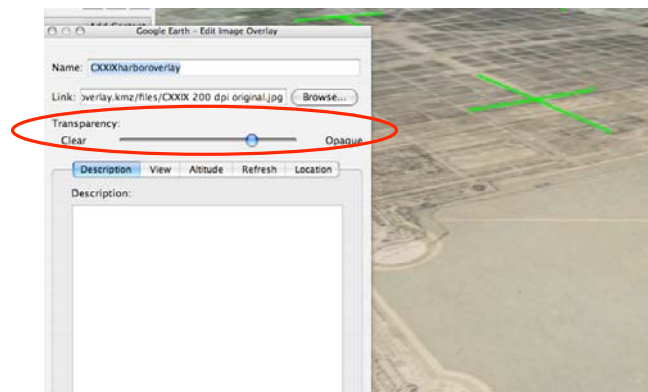
1. Users can download the overlay as well as the three buildings and view them all at once in Google Earth with all four layers checked. You can also turn off any of the four to view one layer individually, layers in pairs, etc. The image to the right shows the Building of Natural Sciences turn on or checked while the Building of Letters to the south of it is turned off or unchecked.



2. The transparency of the overlay image can be controlled by the user by right clicking on the overlay file in the left-hand panel of the window and scrolling to *Properties* on the pc or *Get Info* on the Mac.



3. In the window that appears, the user can control the transparency level by sliding the control lever between "Clear" and "Opaque."



Therefore, the proposed lakefront area and the contemporary lakefront area can be viewed with ease with the buildings in place. This is helpful, as users can compare these layers to analyze what was actually constructed in Grant Park versus what was proposed.
